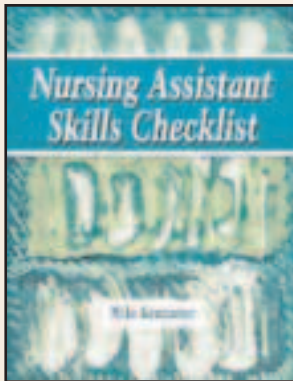


NURSING ASSISTING SKILLS CHECKLISTS
